Notice is hereby given that the Alpine County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing for consideration of a resolution establishing fees for administrative services and products: County Clerk. The County Clerk's Office proposes to remove federal fees from the County Clerk's Fee Schedule. Each year the Clerk's Office must update the fee schedule because of federal rate changes. This causes unnecessary public hearings and unnecessary Board and staff time. Federal fees such as U.S. Department of Fish and Wildlife and U.S. Passport fees change almost every year. Federal fees will be posted on the County Clerk's webpage as well as in the County Clerk's Office. This resolution would supersede and rescind Resolution No. 2015-09 adopted January 20, 2015.


