The Alpine County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing on February 18, 2014 at 10:00 AM or as soon after as the matter can be heard at the Turtle Rock Park Community Center, 17300 Highway 89, Markleeville, CA. to discuss the 2014 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program and to solicit citizen input.

Alpine County is considering applying for a CDBG grant to make certain infrastructure and housing improvements to the Sierra Pines Mobile Home Park located at 19750 Highway 89, Markleeville, CA. The improvements are intended to specifically benefit low and moderate income households. The improvements could potentially include

- Rehabilitation and/or replacement of existing residential mobile home units
- Improvements to access roads and drainage within the park
- Improvements to the water system that serves the park
- Other related improvements

The purpose of the public hearing is to give citizens the opportunity to comment on 2014 CDBG program.
