CAMPING CLOSURE

A. PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following act is prohibited in the area described in this Order, located within the Carson Ranger District, Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest.

1. Camping.
[36 CFR 261.58(e)]

B. EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

C. AREA DESCRIBED

All National Forest System lands located within Alpine County, California.

D. PURPOSE

The purpose of this order, which reflects federal and state guidance to limit the transmission of COVID-19, is to protect public health, and safety.

E. IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Special Order is effective at 12:01 A.M. on April 25, 2020, and shall remain in effect until May 16th, 2020, unless terminated prior to that date.
2. Exhibit A, Map and Exhibit B, definitions are attached and incorporated into this Order.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable as a class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization/or imprisonment of not more than 6 months [Title 16 USC 551, 18 USC 3571 (b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].

EXHIBIT B

DEFINITIONS

CAMPING: Means the temporary use of the National Forest Systems lands for the purpose of overnight occupancy without a permanently-fixed structure. 36 CFR 261.2
