FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: CALTRANS ANNOUNCES HIGHWAY 89 ROAD RE-OPENING TO ONE-WAY CONTROLLED TRAFFIC EFFECTIVE THURSDAY, AUGUST 18, 2022. ALPINE COUNTY WILL HOLD THE FINAL OPERATIONAL BRIEFING ON FRIDAY, AUGUST 19, 2022.
