



EV Charging Station Request for Proposal Questions & Reponses

- What is the anticipated use-case designations for these charging stations in terms of public/municipal/fleet usage?

Answer: The primary use-case designation will be public usage.

- How can we set up a site walk to ensure the availability of our resources to travel to you?

Answer: The Alpine County Economic Development Director can facilitate on-site tours of the sites in partnership with the local utility providers.

- Does any of the preexisting utility side infrastructure have 480V capacity?

Answer: Yes, but actual available capacity will need to be investigated for the final, selected site as part of the utility application for new service. The Liberty EV Infrastructure Program ([Rule 24](#)) is expected to be leveraged for no-cost utility infrastructure.

- Can applicant/supplier work with partners to provide Turn-Key solutions?

Answer: Yes

- Are you already preapproved by a utility provider for make-ready incentives or a like program?

Answer: Yes

- If so, please advise if the supplier, in an owner & operator model, would keep the incentives?

Answer: Yes, the owner operator would receive the incentives and all revenues collected in the operation of the EV Charging Stations less expenses.
